- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer.

The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.

- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a

For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of affiliation by elaws.

- 10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these
- 11. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening conservation and cleanliness etc.
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is
- 13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/upgradation regularly candidates.
- 15. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on
- 16. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- 17. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Chapter 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- 18. Conditions, if any, to be submitted within 01 Year from the receipt of this letter.
 - a) The school is required to submit a copy of "No Objection Certificate" (NOC) issued from the Department of Education, State Government/Competent Authority which is an essential pre condition of the Affiliation Bye-laws.
 - b) Fee of Rs 25000/- submitted by the school is less than that of required amount i.e. 50000/-. Remaining amount of Fee 25000/- is still required (total fee 50000/-, received 25000/-). Hence, school is required to remit Rs.25,000/- towards Inspection Fees to the Board through Demand Draft in favour of Secretary, CBSE, Delhi.
 - c) The school is required to submit Land Certificate their land area, compactness of land, infrastructure, area of playground with documentary evidences in the prescribed Performa as per Appendix VI of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board duly signed by the Competent Authority i.e. Sub-Registrar/Tehsildar/District Magistrate etc. of the State Government.
- d) School authority has submitted its own Society certificate (Safety) due to school is managed and controlled by Indian Explosives Ltd., Orica, Gomia. Hence, the school is required to submit copies of renewed Sanitary Conditions, Drinking Water Building Safety Certificate and Fire Safety Certificates issued by the Competent Govt. Authorities.
- e) The school is required to submit an affidavit in original to the effect that the school is not sponsoring candidates of any other school in the Board's Examination duly sworn in before First Class Magistrate.
